

TOWN OF CARROLLTON PLANNING BOARD

Minutes for February, 2015

Present: Chairman Bob Wood, Julie Chartreau, Florence Fuller, Rolland Corbin, Town Supervisor Bruce Hudson, Town Councilman Ralph Bottone.
Excused: Linda Brown.

The meeting was opened at 5:00 PM by Chairman Wood.

Motion to accept minutes of the January 20, 2015 meeting was made by Linda Brown, seconded by Rolland Corbin.

Chairman Wood , also a Master Forrest Volunteer, *voted no* on the recent effort to change the Building Code for using rough cut lumber. Chairman Wood said he was not in favor of the code and felt comfortable speaking for the Town of Carrollton. Town Supervisor Bruce Hudson agreed with Chairman Wood.

Ginger Malack is spearheading the Cattaraugus County Revitalization Program. As of this date, Chairman Wood said other than Carrollton only the Town of Portville had expressed an interest in this program. There are 37 Towns in the County of Cattaraugus. \$150,000 was granted to the county for this program.

The viewing of the required Roger Brooks Tape was discussed. The board chose 'The 20 Ingredients for an Outstanding Town' as the topic to view. Chairman Wood suggested that if other Communities want to look at other tapes (topics), we could piggy back on them also. This Web Based Seminar (Webinar) will be held on **March 24, 2015** from **6:00 pm until 8:00 pm**. The average time for this webinar is 45 minutes. A discussion will follow. The webinar is open to the public. Town Planning Board members, ZBA members, Town Board members, and property owners are invited to attend. A notice will be prepared by Chairman Wood to be posted at the Post Office, Western Steer, and the Municipal Building bulletin board. Board member Julie Chartreau is an IT specialist in her profession and has volunteered to be in charge of setting up what is necessary for this webinar. All members who attend the webinar will receive one hour training credit.

Julie Chartreau attended a meeting in Little Valley on January 14, 2015. She drew a sketch of a possible trail from the state line to the Seneca Nation. Discussion was had to take the Trail all the way to the River (bridge to bridge). Julie relayed there was much interest in this endeavor. A follow-up meeting is scheduled for March 11, 2015.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:55 PM. Motion made Florence Fuller, seconded by Julie Chartreau.

The next Planning Board meeting is scheduled for March 17, 2015 in the Town Municipal Building at 5:00 PM.
