

TOWN OF CARROLLTON PLANNING BOARD

Minutes for May, 2015

Present: Chairman Bob Wood, Julie Chartreau, Florence Fuller, Rolland Corbin, Linda Brown.

The meeting was opened at 5:00 PM by Chairman Wood.

Motion to accept minutes of the April 21, 2015 meeting was made by Linda Brown, seconded by Rolland Corbin.

The Board met at the Municipal Building lobby and did a walking tour of the property in the back of the building. The area where the former school football and baseball fields were located had been considered for a future park location. After a discussion among the board members it was decided that easy access to this area would be difficult for townspeople. Julie Chartreau then conducted a driving tour for possible future recreational sites. Crossing over Rt. 219 and the Tunungwant Creek, the group started at Railroad Avenue. Julie pointed out that the future Trail would likely begin at Railroad Avenue where the snowmobile trail starts and a Tubing Regatta would also begin at the Bailey Drive Bridge. Everyone then proceeded up Bailey Drive to Parkside Drive which runs parallel to the Tuna Creek, stopping at Rice Brooke Road and then on to Irvine Mills Bridge where the Regatta would end. Everyone was pleased with the tour and agreed that the tour gave all a better understanding of the locations that have been discussed for proposed projects.

Board member Florence Fuller has resigned from the Planning Board effective May 19, 2015. Florence was appointed to the Town of Carrollton Board for the remainder of this year to fill an open vacancy. The open position on the Planning Board will be discussed at the June meeting. Florence will remain a liaison to the Planning Board.

Motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:00 PM made by Linda Brown, seconded by Rolland Corbin.

The next Planning Board meeting is scheduled for June 16, 2015.
